the MOU and will not be disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the

other institute.

b. The above confidential clause under this MOU excludes the information / data possessed by

either institute before entering in this MOU or independently developed and / or information

already available through public domain.

6. Duration of the MOU

This MOU, unless extended by mutual written consent of the institutes, shall expire in THREE year

after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. However, on review, the MOU shall be

extended for another Three year by mutual consent.
